Broadway. Four years later, while enjoying great success on the stage, Nick wrote a song called, "Joy to the World." This eventually led to a record deal for Nick. In 2005, Steve Greenberg, visionary president of Columbia Records, signed the brothers as a group act when he realized that not only did Nick have a great voice, but he had two talented brothers as well.
