Grammy winning country duo Sugarland are hitting the road for their summer There Goes the Neighborhood tour. Kristian Bush and Jennifer Nettles will welcome special guests Mary Chapin Carpenter and Tenille Townes as support. In addition, the duo is releasing a special collection of tracks: a 3-song EP, Bigger, Louder, Live, on Feb. 28 that includes live versions of "On a Roll," "Bigger" and "Babe." - The EP is a call back to the band's sixth studio album BIGGER as they promise a new chapter with fresh music coming this year.

Sugarland is an American country music duo founded in Atlanta, Georgia, consisting of singer-songwriters Jennifer Nettles (lead vocals) and Kristian Bush (vocals, guitar, mandolin). The group was founded in 2002 by these two along with Kristen Hall (vocals, guitar), but she quit after only one album. All three members had experience in folk rock: Nettles had recorded in the groups Soul Miner's Daughter and Jennifer Nettles Band, Bush had recorded two albums as one-half of the duo Billy Pilgrim, and Hall had recorded two solo albums.
